#### **Conditions of Play**

All play will be governed by the current MBA Conditions of Play and the latest version of Crystal Laws of the Sport of Bowls.

#### **Process - Critical Dates**

#### The Games

Sectional play in the initial rounds will be determined by number of entries

All games are to be <u>played by</u> the dates nominated. These can be found on the Draw sheets or on the website.

- All Pairs games are played to 15 ends.
- All Singles games are to 21 shots
- Dead ends are to be replayed

For all single games players must find their own markers.

No tossing of a coin to determine winners. Forfeits by the party who cannot participate
